

Dear parents,

Our school in Mamer is constantly growing and we are expecting about 80 to 100 additional pupils this year. Consequently the traffic around the school will increase accordingly. In order to reduce the traffic impact around our School, we ask you to use the bus or other means of transport as often as possible. If it is unavoidable to come by car, please give priority to the buses to ensure their timely arrival and departure.

The existing network of school buses has been adapted slightly. **Please check the links given below for further information.**

Amongst others, the following changes have been implemented for the coming year:

- Line 76 has been extended serving Kehlen, Tuntange, Saeul, Brouch and Bissen on a direct route. The travel times for most children have been reduced on this line.
- A new Line 77 has been established serving Mamer, Meispel, Keispelt, Mersch, Rollingen and Lintgen on a new route. The travel times for most children have been reduced on this line.
- Line 78 has been extended to Hunsdorf and Blaschette.
- Line 79 now starts and ends in Lorentzweiler with only one bus in the mornings.
- Lines 92, 93B and 97 will start some minutes earlier to ensure a timely arrival.

#### **School bus from Bertrange and Mamer**

- Dedicated school buses provided by the nearby **Communes of Bertrange and Mamer** are numbered **Bertrange 1, Mamer 1 and Mamer 2**. These buses are free but only available for children of Nursery, Primary and the first year of Secondary. Older pupils are asked to use the public buses (e.g. 222) or other means of transport. **\*IMPORTANT\*** Improvements on Mamer bus lines are planned for this new school year. The new timetables are not available at that time but will be placed on APEEEL2 website ahead the first day of new school year. - Nursery and Primary children will be accompanied to the relevant bus. A **special form** will be given by the class teacher. Please ensure that the relevant card is issued, identifying the bus which will be used by your child.

#### **School bus from Luxembourg Ville**

- Dedicated school buses are serving **Luxembourg Ville** (including Beggen, Dommeldange, Howald) which are numbered from **92 to 98**. These can be used by all Nursery and Primary children without a ticket. Secondary pupils require a *carte d'élève myCard* (issued by the School for free for all secondary children). - Nursery and Primary children will be accompanied to the relevant bus. A **special form** will be given by the class teacher. Please ensure that the relevant card is issued, identifying the bus which will be used by your child.

#### **School bus from other parts of Luxembourg**

- Buses provided by ATSEEE serving **the remaining parts of the country** are numbered from **70 to 86** and users have to register in advance at the relevant webpage (<https://atsee.eu/customer-login/>). If at least one member of the family works for an EU Institution, the expenses are usually borne by the relevant institution. There are different rules and subsidies for employees of the EU Financial Institutions (e.g. EIB, EIF, ESM,

#### Navettes from the EU-Institutions

- In addition, ATSEEE provides **supervised Navettes** between the EU Institutions, the School and the CPE. Users have to register in advance at the relevant webpage ([www.ATSEEE.eu](http://www.ATSEEE.eu)). If at least one member of the family works for an EU Institution, the expenses are usually borne by the relevant institution. There are different rules and subsidies for employees of the EU Financial Institutions (e.g. EIB, EIF, ESM, etc.) please check the relevant rules within your Institution. #### Public buses Ligne 28, 218, 222, 248, 250, 255 and 260

- **Ligne 28** from Luxembourg Ville runs directly during school hours every 30 minutes. The RGTR Lines (e.g. 218, 222, 248, 250, 255, 260) are serving the nearby bus stop “Mamer-Tosseberg”. These lines can be used by all Nursery and Primary children without a ticket. Secondary pupils require a **carte d’élève myCard** (issued by the School for free for all secondary children). #### Train

- Our school can be easily reached via the CFL Ligne 50 from Luxembourg to Kleinbettingen and Arlon via the train station “Mamer-Lycée”. The train can be used by all Nursery and Primary children without a ticket. Secondary pupils require a **carte d’élève myCard** (issued by the School for free for all secondary children).
